



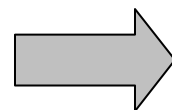
Parents Code of Conduct

On behalf of the Rec Board, we would like to thank you for including your children in our Rec program. Your participation requires that you follow the following code of conduct.

1. Parents are to conduct themselves in a professional and dignified manner.
2. Parents are to treat your child's team members, other team members, coaches and other parents with respect, at all times.
3. Parents should understand the rules and realize the rules are to be followed regardless of your personal belief in the validity of the rule.
4. Parents desiring changes to the rules should submit their ideas, in writing, to the Rec Board for review and possible implementation in future seasons.
5. Parents are to realize that talent levels, abilities, and personal circumstances differ. All team members should play an equal or approximately equal amount. However, equal playing time is not guaranteed for 7th grade players and older.
6. Parents are to realize that while winning is fun; Central St. Croix Rec is first and foremost a recreational league with an emphasis on fun, sportsmanship, teamwork, and fundamentals.
7. Parents are to realize coaches and others devote time and energy to practice and games. They are not certified, paid coaches, they are volunteers. If you have constructive criticism to offer, do so privately. If you have a problem with a coach, submit your concerns, in writing, to the Board for their review. Thank coaches, be patient, think about all kids not just yours, and above all, if you have not volunteered to coach, put yourself in their shoes before you speak.
8. Parents should direct any conflicts to the Board. Do not put kids or their games in the middle of YOUR issues.
9. Parents should make every effort to get kids to practice and games on time. In the event you are unable to attend a game, please inform the coach. Coaches are here for the love of the game and the love of kids, treat them with respect and help them succeed.

Following these simple, common sense guidelines is essential for the total success of our program. Total success means no one walks away wondering if they will play next year.

Players Code of Conduct

We would like to welcome you to Central St. Croix Rec. We are happy to have you as a participant. We require that you follow the following code of conduct:

1. Players are to conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner.
2. Players are to treat team members, opposing team members, coaches and parents with respect.
3. Players are to follow adopted rules, without exception, regardless of personal feelings or your parents' view of the rules.
4. Players are to realize that talent levels, abilities, and personal circumstances differ. Teammates will all play a similar amount but may not be equal.. Poor sportsmanship toward your team or others will not be tolerated.
5. Players are to realize that while winning is fun; Central St. Croix Rec is first and foremost a recreational league with an emphasis on fun, sportsmanship, teamwork, and fundamentals. Sportsmanship is demonstrated as much in a loss as in a win. Show pride and class at all times.
6. Players are to realize parents, grandparents and others devote time and energy getting you to practice and games, they come to watch you play. Do not disappoint them with a bad attitude or a lack of honest effort.
7. Players may be held out of a starting spot for missing practice, but the player shall not be made to sit "extra" time.
8. Players must realize that coaches are volunteers, not professionals; umps, refs and others are not full time officials, they do their best and you must respect their decisions even when you believe they are wrong.
